Hungary's wine culture is characterized by diversity, originality and uniqueness. In the 6 wine regions of the country, 22 wine districts with different climatological, topographical, soil and historical characteristics can be discovered. At the six-item wine tasting, 3 wine regions and 5 different wine districts of Hungary will be presented through the typical wines of the given production area:

PANNON WINE REGION:

- Vida Péter – Hidaspetre Kékfrankos 2016
- Bock Borászat – Ermitage 2015

TOKAJ WINE REGION:

- Tokaj-Hétszőlő Birtok – Furmint Selection BIO 2017
- Chateau Dereszla – Tokaji Édes Szamorodni 2013
